## sunday evening gathering - FAQs

#### When will the service meet?

Sunday evenings, at 6:30p, starting on October  $4^{\scriptscriptstyle th}$ . It will meet every week for 10 weeks, then take a break for Christmas.

#### Is this service going to be different than Sunday mornings?

Yes and no. There will be a different worship leader/band and a different speaker, but the message will use the same scripture text as Sunday mornings so you will still be on the same track with the Sunday messages.

#### Why are we starting an evening service?

We think there are a number of people in the area who would like to attend church but are unavailable on Sunday mornings. This will give them the opportunity to be a part of a community of believers where they can hear God's word.

#### How long will the service last?

It will be approximately the same length as the Sunday morning services – roughly an hour and fifteen minutes.

#### Will there be children's programs?

There will be childcare for children ages 0 to 5 years, but we will not be offering full kid's classes at this time.
