Use these questions in your community group time to dig deeper and discover how you can apply today's message to everyday life.

- 1. Genesis 11:4 tells us that the mission statement of the workers in Babel was: "Let us make a name for ourselves." Re-read the story of Babel in Genesis 11:1-9. Consider your attitude toward work. Think about your job, your obligations, your hobbies. Why do you work? If someone were to look at your life from the outside, what would they say is your mission statement?
- 2. On Sunday we discussed John 19:30. On the cross Jesus says, "It is finished." His work on our behalf is completed. All that is necessary has been done. Many in our culture live as though this is not the case, as though we have to work to justify our existence. Consider how you work. To what degree do you rest in Christ's work? To what degree are you using work to justify yourself?
- 3. Read 1 Corinthians 10:31. What would it look like for you to work for God's ultimate glory in the world? What are small ways you can practice this in your work at your job, in your home, and at your church?
